Jennie has worked at the Memorial for over a decade in a variety of roles, during which time she has built an extensive knowledge of the Memorial's collections and how to research Australian military service. Jennie regularly delivers presentations and training on the Memorial's resources and how to make best use of them when researching those who have served with Australian military forces. During her time in the Research Centre Jennie has helped innumerable researchers and visitors to the Memorial discover the stories of their relative's military service. Recently Jennie co-curated the Memorial's temporary exhibition *Anzac voices*. The exhibition told the stories of those serving with Australian forces in the First World War through their own accounts and featured treasures from the Memorial's archives, many on display for the first time.
