Finding family in New Zealand

Summary

Did your family disappear from Australian records either for good or for a short period? Maybe they will turn up in New Zealand records. This talk will explain the basic records for New Zealand research and their locations and websites.

Abstract

The talk will explore birth, marriage and death records – what they contain and how to access them. It will also touch on Church records and the locations of the archives of the main religions. School records provide evidence of location and often the occupation of the male parent. Other records which assist with location and occupation are Electoral Rolls and Directories. Probate records often provide extra information and proof of relationships and newspaper reports will often untangle a family mystery.
